## PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY

### Wethersfield Parish Council (Blackmore End Ward)

Wethersfield Parish Council is seeking to co-opt a new parish councillor to fill a vacancy which has recently occurred in the Blackmore End Ward (although as the Council is grouped, councillors represent the whole community – Wethersfield, Blackmore End and Beazley End).

The Council meets approximately 10 times a year, usually on a Wednesday, and the meetings alternate between the village halls in Wethersfield and Blackmore End.

Parish Councillors volunteer their time to work on behalf of their local community. If you have lived in the Parish, or within 3 miles of it, for at least a year and are over 18, you are probably eligible (please check with the clerk for further eligibility criteria). Training will be given by the Essex Association of Local Councils (funded by the Parish Council).

Wethersfield Parish Council is an independent local authority with powers, duties and responsibilities. It is completely independent of County and District, and is managed by a Council elected every four years.

If you would like to express your interest, please submit a letter of application giving brief reasons why you should be considered for the vacancy, to the Parish Clerk at the address below by 5<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

A decision to co-opt an applicant will be made at the next meeting of the Parish Council which will be held on Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> January 2018.
