PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY (Wethersfield Ward)

Wethersfield Parish Council is seeking to co-opt a parish councillor to fill the vacancy which has recently occurred in the ward of Wethersfield (although as the Council is grouped, councillors represent the whole community – Wethersfield, Blackmore End and Beazley End).

The Council meets approximately 10 times a year, usually on the second Wednesday of the month, and the meetings alternate between the village halls in Wethersfield and Blackmore End.

Parish Councillors volunteer their time to work on behalf of their local community. If you have lived in the Parish, or within 3 miles of it, for at least a year and are over 18, you are probably eligible (please check with the clerk for further eligibility criteria). Training will be given by the Essex Association of Local Councils (funded by the Parish Council).

Wethersfield Parish Council is an independent local authority with powers, duties and responsibilities. It is completely independent of County and District, and is managed by a Council elected every four years.

If you would like to observe the next meeting to see what is involved, please contact the clerk or alternatively just turn up at Blackmore End Village Hall on Wednesday, 13th June at 7.30pm.

To express your interest, please submit a letter of application giving brief reasons why you should be considered for the vacancy to the clerk at the address below, by Tuesday, 3rd July 2018.

A decision to co-opt applicants will be made at the meeting on Wednesday, 11th July 2018.
