



Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

The Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006

The above regulations require Braintree District Council to carry out a review of its Polling Districts and Polling Places on a regular four-yearly cycle.

We are looking for feedback on any aspect of Polling Districts and/or Polling Places currently used and invite representation and comments from interested persons. A full list of Polling Places is available at www.braintree.gov.uk

Local political parties and Councillors will be consulted and views are invited from electors within the Parliamentary Constituencies of Braintree and Witham as well as such persons as may have particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.

Local community groups will also be consulted.

The consultation period for the review will commence on **Monday 1 October 2018** and end on **Wednesday 31 October 2018**

The review focuses on Polling Districts and Polling Places it is however accepted that Polling Stations are an integral part of election delivery and as such comments are invited about stations currently used.
